

PROGRAM 2

Cartoon Portrait Design (1 x 2 hour session)

Concept

Using the fundamental theories and practice of portraiture drawing, students will be encouraged to draw themselves or another person they admire. Similar to the emoji curriculum, the theme will be the interpretations of emotions as well as understanding basic human anatomy. Students will have the choice of mediums such as graphite pencils, colour pencils, acrylic or watercolour painting.

Learning Outcomes

1. Learn portrait drawing and painting skills
2. Improving basic character drawing and painting skills.
3. Developing a personal art style that will resonate with their unique creative vision
4. Observing 3D shapes how it can be matched with their 2D portrait painting

VAES 1.1:

- Continues to explore characteristics of people and focuses more on details, such as facial features.
- Make drawings and paintings about things and people that interest them and their experiences

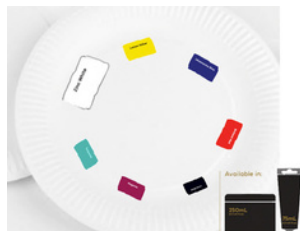
